We are committed to the continuous improvement of our environmental performance and the prevention of pollution. To this end, we shall comply with the requirements of: BS EN ISO 9001: 2008

Within this framework we undertake to:

- ◆ Establish systems that ensure we are aware of applicable Legislation and Regulations.

All employees shall be trained & encouraged to participate in the implementation of good environmental management practice. We shall promote & support the adoption and continuous improvement of effective environmental practices by our customers, suppliers & contractors.

Our Main Areas of Impact - Franco Fire Detection is committed to reducing the impact of operations on the environment and has identified 4 key areas where we impact upon the environment:

1. Energy
2. Waste
3. Water
4. Transport

Within each impact theme we will address practices and standard specifications which underpin our activities and provide information to our staff, customers and stakeholders to make the necessary behavioural changes to minimise the environmental impact.

Energy – The Franco Fire Detection office has reduced its energy consumption by ensuring all electrical equipment is not left on standby, but switched off over night and whenever it is not in use. This includes a new energy efficient printer/scanner machine. All employees have been instructed to ensure lighting is switched off when the room is not in use.

Waste – Franco Fire Detection is committed to ensuring that our company produces a minimum amount of waste. This includes instructing staff to return to the office any old equipment that can be recycled so we may forward it to the relevant supplier. Franco Fire Detection office has reduced printing hard copies of documents by using a new electronic system that has recently been introduced. As stated above Franco Fire Detection complies with the WEEE directive in partnership with our suppliers.

Water – Our water usage is kept to a minimum.

Transport – At Franco Fire Detection we take our responsibility to reduce the environmental costs of transport very seriously. Our engineers have been on an advanced driving course to improve their awareness of driving more economically. All our works are arranged to keep travelling time to a minimum.
